FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric A	FUS-SD-1100	1 1/3 yd.
Fabric B	FUS-SD-1108	1/4 yd.
Fabric C	FUS-SD-1101	5/8 yd.
Fabric D	FUS-SD-1107	1/2 yd.
Fabric E	FUS-SD-1102	1/3 yd.
Fabric F	PE-442	1/4 yd.
Fabric G	PE-433	1 1/8 yd.

BINDING FABRIC

Fabric E FUS-SD-1102 (Included)

BACKING FABRIC

FUS-SD-1104 (Recommended) 4 yds.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

1/4" seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.

- Sixteen (16) 12 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles from fabric **A**.
- Sixteen (16) 10 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles from fabric **A** and **G**.
- Sixteen (16) 8 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles from fabric **A** and **G**.
- Sixteen (16) 6 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles from fabric **A**.
- Sixteen (16) 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles from fabric **B**.
- Eight (8) 6 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles from fabric **C** and **F**.
- Eight (8) 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles from fabric **C** and **F**.
- Eight (8) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares from fabric **C** and **D**.
- Sixteen (16) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares from fabric **B** and **G**.
- Five (5) WOF x 2 1/2" strips from fabric **G**.
- Subcut two (2) 52 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips from fabric **G**.
- Subcut two (2) 48 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips from fabric **G**.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with 1/4" seam allowance.

Block 1:

- Take one (1) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square from fabric **G** and **B**.
- Join them making sure fabric **G** is to the right:



DIAGRAM 1

- Take one (1) 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle from fabric **B** and join it to the top:

- Take one (1) 4 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle from fabric **F** and join it to the left:

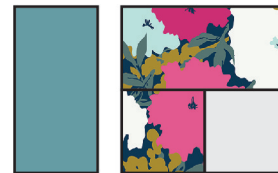


DIAGRAM 3

- Take one (1) 6 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle from fabric **F** and join it to the top:

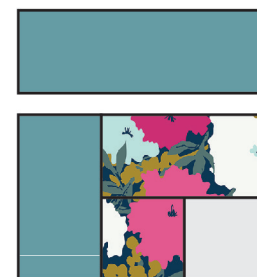


DIAGRAM 4
