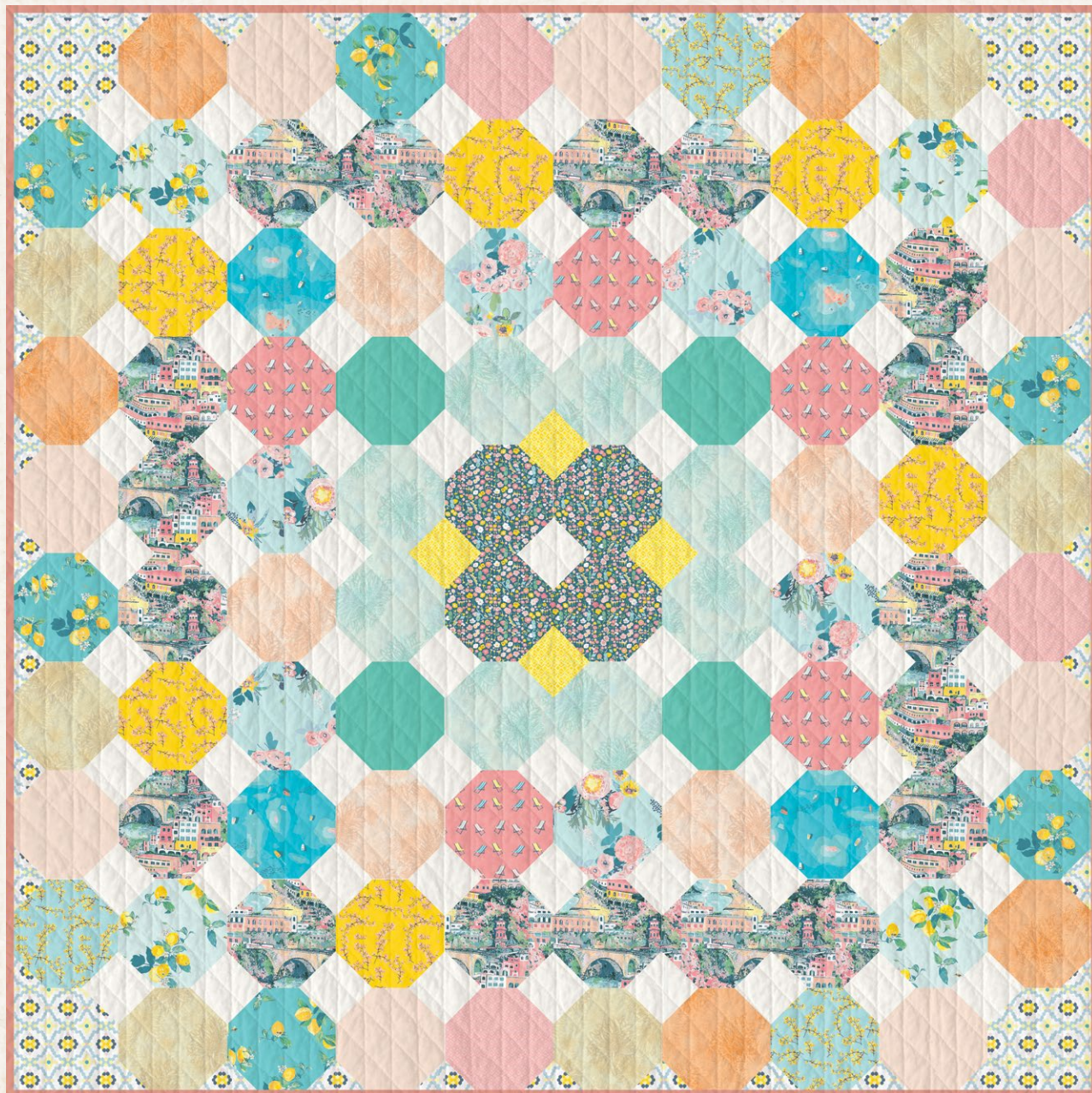
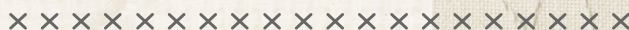

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

¼" seam allowances are included.  
WOF means width of fabric.

- Five (5) 6½" squares from fabric **A**.
- Six (6) 6½" squares from fabric **B**.
- Four (4) 6½" squares from fabric **C**.
- Six (6) 6½" squares from fabric **D**.
- Four (4) 6½" squares from fabric **E**.
- Six (6) 6½" squares from fabric **F**.
- Four (4) 6½" squares from fabric **G**.
- Five (5) 6½" squares from fabric **H**.
- Six (6) 6½" squares from fabric **I**.
- Five (5) 6½" squares from fabric **J**.
- Four (4) 6½" squares from fabric **K**.
- Four (4) 6½" squares from fabric **L**.
- Sixteen (16) 2½" squares from fabric **M**.
- Three (3) 6½" squares from fabric **N**.
- Four (4) 6½" squares from fabric **O**.
- Sixty four (64) 2½" squares from fabric **O**.
- Eighteen (18) 6½" squares from fabric **P**.
- Eight (8) 6½" squares from fabric **Q**.
- Eight (8) 6½" squares from fabric **R**.
- Three hundred and eight (308) 2½" squares from fabric **S**.

# CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

## Snowball construction:

- Take four (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and one (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
- Align one (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the top left corner of the  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the fabric of the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square and sew on the line.
- Trim excess fabric leaving  $\frac{1}{4}$ " of seam allowance.
- Press open.
- Repeat these steps for the remaining 3 corners, following the diagram below.

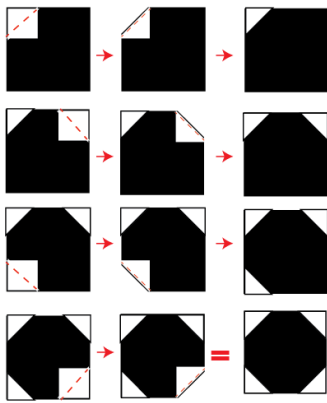


DIAGRAM 1

- To create blocks 1, 2, 3 and 4, take forty two (42)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabrics **S** and **O**, five (5)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabric **A**, six (6)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabrics **B** and **D** and four (4)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabric **C** and follow the snowball instructions in order to make your blocks, following the diagram below.

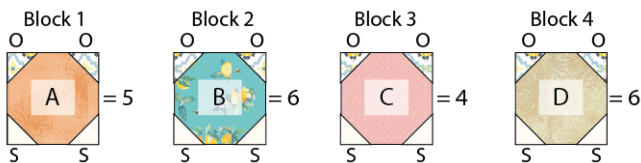


DIAGRAM 2

- To create blocks 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 15, take two hundred and eight (208)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabric **S**, four (4)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabrics **E**, **G**, **K**, six (6)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabrics **F** and **I**, five (5)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabrics **H** and **J** and eighteen (18)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabric **P** and follow the diagram below for each block assembly.

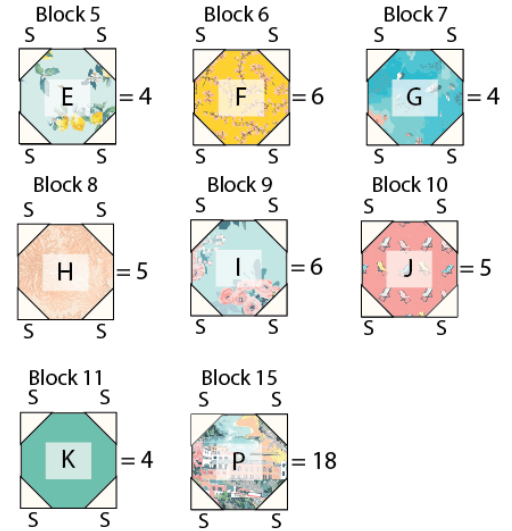


DIAGRAM 3

- To assemble blocks 12 and 13, take eight (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabrics **M** and **S** and four (4)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabric **L**. Follow the diagram below for each block assembly

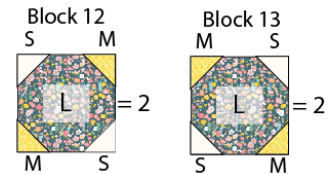


DIAGRAM 4

- For blocks 14 and 16, take twenty two (22)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabrics **O** and **S**, three (3)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabric **N** and eight (8)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from fabric **R**.

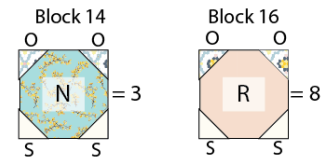
