Cutting Diagram for fabrics A, B and C.

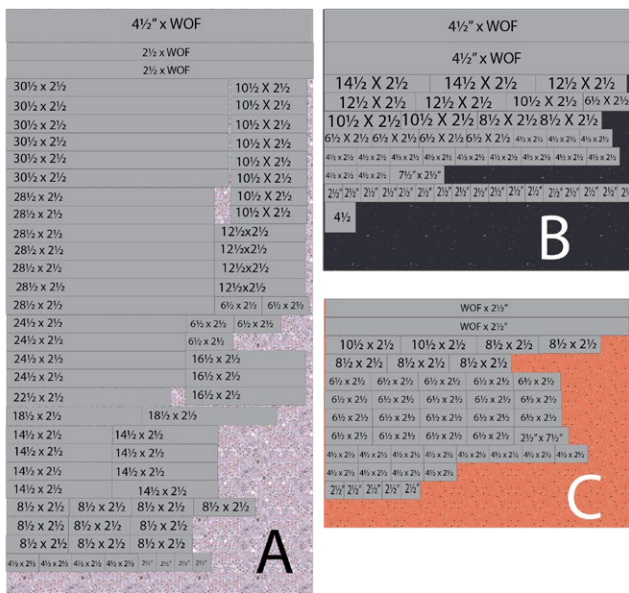


DIAGRAM 1

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

¼" seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.

Fabric A

- One (1) WOF x 4½" strips.
- Two (2) WOF x 2½" strips.
- Twenty seven (27) WOF x 2½" strips.

SUBCUT:

- Six (6) 30½" x 2½" strips.
- Seven (7) 28½" x 2½" strips.
- Four (4) 24½" x 2½" strips.
- One (1) 22½" x 2½" strip.
- Two (2) 18½" x 2½" strips.
- Three (3) 16½" x 2½" strips.
- Seven (7) 14½" x 2½" strips.
- Four (4) 12½" x 2½" strips.
- Eight (8) 10½" x 2½" strips.
- Ten (10) 8½" x 2½" strips
- Five (5) 6½" x 2½" strips.
- Four (4) 4½" x 2½" strips.
- Four (4) 2½" squares.

Fabric B

- Two (2) WOF x 4½" strips.
- Eight (8) WOF x 2½" strips.

SUBCUT

- Two (2) 14½" x 2½" strips.
- Three (3) 12½" x 2½" strips.
- Three (3) 10½" x 2½" strips.
- Two (2) 8½" x 2½" strips.
- Five (5) 6½" x 2½" strips.
- Fourteen (14) 4½" x 2½" rectangles.
- One (1) 4½" square.
- Seventeen (17) 2½" squares.
- One (1) 7½" x 2½" rectangle.

CONSTRUCTION

Fabric C

- Two (2) WOF x 2½" strips.
- Nine (9) WOF x 2½" strips.

Subcut:

- Two (2) 10½" x 2½" strips.
- Five (5) 8½" x 2½" strips.
- Nineteen (19) 6½" x 2½" strips.
- Twelve (12) 4½" x 2½" rectangles.
- Five (5) 2½" squares.
- One (1) 7½" x 2½" rectangle.

Fabric D

- Four (4) WOF x 2½" strips.
- One (1) 10½" x 2½" strip.
- Three (3) 8½" x 2½" strips.
- Two (2) 6½" x 2½" strips.
- Six (6) 4½" x 2½" rectangles.
- Twenty one (21) 2½" squares.

Fabric E

- One (1) WOF x 2½" strip.

Fabric F

- Ten (10) 2½" squares.

Fabric G

- Two (2) WOF x 2½" strips.

Fabric H

- One (1) 4½" square.

Fabric I (Binding)

- Seven (7) WOF x 2½" strips.

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance.

- Join one (1) WOF x 2½" from fabric **A** and one (1) WOF x 2½" from fabric **B** as shown on diagram below.
- Now, cut eleven (11) 2½" vertical strips.
- These sets will be SS1.

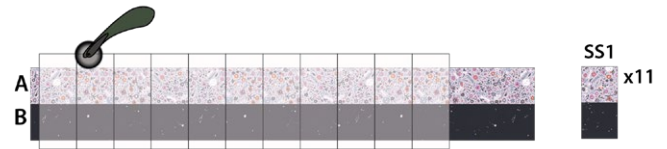


DIAGRAM 2

- Join one (1) WOF x 2½" from fabric **A** and one (1) WOF x 4½" from fabric **B**. Now, subcut eight (8) 2½" vertical strips.
- These sets will be SS2.

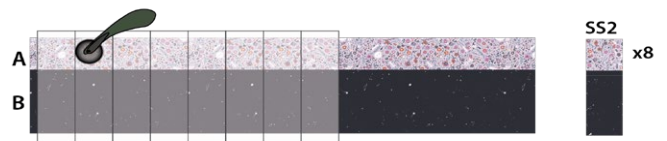


DIAGRAM 3

- Join one (1) WOF x 4½" from fabric **B** and one (1) WOF x 1½" from fabric **A**. Now, subcut ten (10) 2½" vertical strips ,
- These strip sets will be SS3.

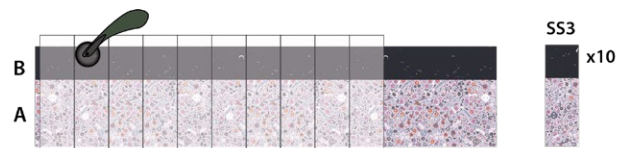


DIAGRAM 4

- Take one (1) WOF x 4½" from fabric **B** and One (1) WOF x 2½" from fabric **E** and sew them together.
